

Sancta Familia Academy 2008 – 2009 Registration Information

Membership - All families must pay the membership registration fee and submit the membership request form in order to be eligible to enroll in Sancta Familia Academy or any of our educational programs. Enrolling in the Academy or an educational program is not required. Options are listed below.

Academic & Enrichment Classes - Homeschool students and students enrolled in Sancta Familia Academy can choose from a variety of academic core classes as well as enrichment classes offered on campus. Classes are taught by knowledgeable and experienced Christian instructors.

Courses are offered in Math, English, Latin, Spanish, Religion, History, Geography, Science, Art, Music, and Sign Language for students in Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Private School Enrollment - Students who are educated at home, as well as students taking classes at Sancta Familia, may choose to enroll in the Academy as registered students with a Florida private school. SFA keeps all student records, prepares report cards and transcripts, and issues diplomas for enrolled students.

- Distance Students are those who are enrolled in the Academy for record keeping services and complete their school work off campus under the direction of a parent-teacher.
- Campus Students are those who are enrolled in the Academy for record keeping and classes, participating in SFA teacher directed courses and completing some assigned work at home. (*Classical Academy, University School*)
- Some enrolled students take a portion of their courses at SFA while studying other courses directed by the parent-teacher. SFA requires the enrollment forms from Campus and Distance students. This allows for parent directed courses and record maintenance on off-campus work days for Campus students as well as participation in special programs and field trips for Distance students without the need for additional paper work throughout the school year.

Courses Available 2008 - 2009

A course catalog will be available in June. We will be in Cycle 3. This means that Grammar students will be in Christian Studies III, Famous Men of the Middle Ages, and Zoology. English, Latin, and Math will be determined by grade level and placement testing.

Please check the website for updates throughout the summer. We will also be scheduling Orientations and Open Houses for June, July, and August.

Registration

In order to participate in any and all programs offered at Sancta Familia Academy, families must Register and become members of our organization. Registration entitles families to all membership benefits including eligibility for our on-campus classes and activities. Membership is for one school year from July through June.

Registration Fee: \$125.00 per family if paid before May 31st / \$150 if June 1st or later

Co-op / University School (Grades 7 – 12)

Registration entitles families to enroll a student in our Co-op Program and take classes at the academy. Tuition and book fees for classes are listed in the Course Catalog.

Program Fee: \$50 per student, per year (Subject to increase pending NAUMS membership.)

Application Fee: \$50 per NEW student

Enrollment Fee: See Record Keeping Services below for optional private school enrollment.

Classical Academy (Grades K – 6)

Registration entitles families to enroll a student in our Classical School and take a thorough elementary course of study at the Academy. Book Fees and Material Fees will be assessed.

Application Fee: \$50 per NEW student

Program Fee: \$150 per year, per student for 3 and 4 Day Core, \$100 per year, per student for 1 or 2 Days.

Tuition: 2-Day Core Curriculum - \$1700 per year pre-paid (or \$180 per month)

3-Day Core Curriculum* - \$2400 per year pre-paid (or \$250 per month)

4-Day Core plus Enrichment* - \$2900 per year pre-paid (or \$300 per month)

1-Day Enrichment Only - \$950 per year pre-paid (or \$100 per month)

*3 and 4 day Core Curriculum includes private school enrollment and Record Keeping Services. See below to add private school enrollment and record keeping for students attending less than 3 days per week.

Record Keeping Services

Students may be enrolled in Sancta Familia Academy in compliance with compulsory education laws to have permanent records and transcripts kept and receive report cards and diplomas. Parents will receive guidance in implementing their educational program and selecting curriculum. See Requirements for Enrollment.

Prices are in addition to Registration Fee and any other Program Fees and Course Tuition. (Classical School Students enrolled in the 3 or 4 Day Core Curriculum, are automatically enrolled in SFA and receive Record Keeping Services at no additional charge. Distance Students inquire about enrollment without membership.

Enrollment Fee: \$50 per NEW student, \$25 per re-enrolling student**

Tuition: \$ 75 per year (or \$10 per month) for Kindergarten

\$125 per year (or \$15 per month) for grades 1 – 8

\$175 per year (or \$20 per month) for grades 9 - 12

**Students in good standing, who re-enroll before July 1st are not required to pay an enrollment fee. Students who re-enroll after June 31st must pay a re-enrollment fee of \$25. Students who are dismissed or have a lapse in enrollment must pay the new student enrollment fee of \$50.

Senior Graduation Fee - \$50

Senior Transfer Fee - for NEW students entering in 12th grade: \$100

High School Transfer Fee - for NEW students entering 10th or 11th grade: \$50

Group Standardized Testing: \$35 for enrolled students / \$45 for non-enrolled members / \$65 for non-members

Placement testing included in Enrollment Fee / Application Fee
