<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 box crayons (24 count)</li> <li>1 box of colored pencils</li> <li>1 pack fine-tipped markers</li> <li>1 pair scissors</li> <li>1 bottle Elmer's glue</li> <li>2 glue sticks</li> <li>1 small plastic box for art supplies</li> <li>1 Individual manual pencil sharpener with case to collect shavings</li> <li>1 zippered fabric pencil pouch for pens/pencils</li> <li>2 highlighters</li> <li>4 blue or black pens</li> <li>2 red pens</li> <li>12 pencils (4 in pencil case and keep rest at home to replenish personal supply as needed)</li> <li>1 package post-it notes</li> <li>1 two-pocket "homework" folder (no prongs)</li> <li>1ea. pocket thesaurus and dictionary</li> <li>\$10 for Catholic Student Planner</li> <li>128 MB or higher jump drive (recommended)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 packages loose-leaf notebook paper (college-rule) (1 in binders, 1 at home, 1 to classroom)</li> <li>1 package 12 count #2 pencils</li> <li>1 pack of pencil cap erasers</li> <li>1 package of graph paper (4 squares per inch)</li> <li>2 reams computer paper (1 for home/1 for classroom)</li> <li>1 package dry-erase markers (black only)</li> <li>2 boxes of tissues</li> <li>1 bottle of hand sanitizer - UNSCENTED</li> </ul> <p><i>Please label ONLY personal items with student's name.
